

Hopkinton Polyarts Festival Show Rules and Regulations

To be accepted for Polyarts, you must submit an application with photos and application check by May 1, 2022. Your craft will be juried and you will be notified of your acceptance or rejection by the Polyarts committee. See application for additional information and exact jury date. This show generally fills at jury time so please be sure to apply by May 1st.

Directions: Route 135, Main Street, Hopkinton Common – approximately 1/4 mile east of the intersection of Route 135 and 85. Exit 21A off Route I-495

Set-up Summary:

1. Polyarts will not be cancelled due to bad weather. Festival will continue, **RAIN OR SHINE.**
2. Set-up begins at 7 a.m. **NO EARLIER DUE TO TOWN REGULATIONS.**
3. Vehicles are not allowed on the Common. We appreciate unloading your vehicle and moving it away from the Common to allow customer parking. After unloading your items, park behind Center School. Volunteers will direct you.
4. Bring your own chairs, tables and canopies and/or free-standing displays.
5. Canopy tents and weights are mandatory. No stakes allowed due to sprinkler system. We suggest using milk jugs filled with water or sand to weigh down your canopy poles.
6. No electricity available.
7. No dogs are allowed on the town common.
8. No raffles or solicitations.
9. Sell only what you submitted in your application. Non-approved items will not be allowed for sale.

Food Vendors: A PERMIT FROM HOPKINTON BOARD OF HEALTH IS MANDATORY. Permit application must be completed by August 1st. You may contact the Board of Health at 508-497-9725.

Food: A variety of foods are available for purchase throughout the festival.

Take- Down Summary: DISPLAYS MAY NOT BE DISMANTLED UNTIL AFTER 4PM.
